DESTINATION INFO

CAMBODIA

- Weather: October is hot and humid on average between +25 to +30C
- Capital: Phnom Phen
- Safety: Relatively safe, however exercise precaution
- Time zone change: +7hrs GMT
- Dress code: Avoid clothing that is too revealing. Temples require to cover between shoulders and knees
- Main tourist attractions: Siem Reap and Angkor Watt
- Visas: Visa on arrival for up to 30 days GBP 25. Need to provide 2 passport sized photos in colour.
- Covid & Vaccines: Covid vaccine or PCR test not required. Hepatitis A, Tetanus and Typhoid
- Validity of passport: 6 months



THAILAND

- Weather: October averages are +30 with rainy season coming to an end
- Capital: Bangkok
- Safety: Relatively safe, however exercise precaution
- Time zone change: +7hrs GMT
- Dress code: Modest for visiting temples
- Main tourist attractions: Bangkok, island hopping, Chiang Mai
- Visas: Visa on arrival for up to 30 days GBP 45.
- Covid & Vaccines: Covid vaccine or PCR test required. Need to be vaccinated. Recommended other vaccines: Tetanus, Hepatitis A, B
- Validity of passport: 6 months





COUNTRY INFO

CAMBODIA

Cambodia is known for its cultural heritage and beautiful nature. Angkor Watt is the largest religious monument in the world and UNESCO World Heritage site. It is a truly memorable experience you will have. Whilst in Siem Reap, Tonle Sap Lake and traditional water floating villages on Mekong River are also worth a visit. It is largest freshwater lake in South East Asia.

THAILAND

Thailand is arguably one of the most visited countries in South East Asia. It has amazed tourists for decades by its natural beauty, culture, lifestyle and food. Bangkok is a buzzing capital where you can experience everything from temples such as Wat Pho, Wat Arun, Royal Grand Palace to floating markets and backpacker nightlife street Khao San. Indulge yourself by having delicious Thai food.

Once you will leave Bangkok, Thailand becomes very different and rural. You can visit traditional city Chiang Mai in north or head to more southern regions with islands such as Kho Samui, Kho Phangan, Phuket, Krabi and many more. Islands offer relaxation by the beach and island hopping trips to popular places like Phi Phi islands and Maya Beach.

Khao Sok has oldest evergreen rainforest in the world and you can experience jungle wildlife and experience a night on a basic water bungalow.
